For over 100 years, the riverbed has been contaminated with toxic chemicals.



The longer we wait, the further the contamination spreads.

All 17 miles of the Lower Passaic River and all of Newark Bay should be dredged to permanently remove the toxic material.



The dredged sediments can and should be treated so they will be safe and usable. The sediment should not be reburied in a confined disposal facility in Newark Bay.
