

THE GROUND WATER PROTECTION COMMITTEE

In the central Passaic River basin, over 70% of the residents depend on groundwater for their drinking water supplies. In the Highlands, nearly everyone uses groundwater. The Ground Water Protection Committee (GWPC, formerly PVGWPC for "Passaic Valley") was established in 1980 to provide a coordinated perspective on groundwater management throughout the Passaic River watershed. Since its founding, the GWPC has been continuously involved in research and education on this region's groundwater resources.

Today, GWPC remains the only inter-municipal organization dedicated to the preservation and enhancement of groundwater in the State of New Jersey. It serves as an advisory board on topics such as recharge, stream base flow, and maintenance of adequate water supplies for the counties, municipalities, and people within the Passaic River watershed. The Ground Water Summit provides a forum for public discussion on these crucial issues.

Directions to the Hanover Manor:

The Hanover Manor is located on Eagle Rock Avenue in East Hanover, NJ. Entrance to parking lot is from Eastbound or Westbound Eagle Rock Avenue.

From Route 80 West – Use Exit 52. At end of ramp, make a right onto Two Bridges Rd. which will lead into Passaic Avenue. Take Passaic Avenue to the end and make a right onto Eagle Rock Ave. Take Eagle Rock Ave. about 1 mile until you see Hanover Manor on right.

From Garden State Parkway North - Take Parkway North to exit 145 (Route 280). Take Route 280 West to Exit 4A. At first traffic light, make a right turn onto Eagle Rock Ave. Go about 1 mile to Hanover Manor, on the right.

From Garden State Parkway South - Take Parkway South to Route 80 West. Take Route 80 West to exit 52. At end of ramp, make a right onto Two Bridges Rd. which will lead into Passaic Avenue. Take Passaic Avenue to the end and make a right onto Eagle Rock Avenue. Take Eagle Rock Ave. about 1 mile until you see Hanover Manor on right.

From Route 80 East - Take Route 80 East to the Route 280 cutoff. Take Route 280 East to Exit 4A. At first traffic light, make a right onto Eagle Rock Avenue. Take Eagle Rock Avenue about 1 mile to Hanover Manor on right.

Frequently coming from the use of salt on roads during winter, the melting snow and ice flows enter into our rivers, streams, lakes, ponds, and aquifers. Increasing levels of salt in water can be harmful to infants, diabetics and the elderly, and can increase blood pressure. It is further harmful to crops and the landscape overall.

The Ground Water Summit will provide information on the increasing problem, and provide solutions for consideration by public officials, Department of Public Works superintendents, health officers, environmental commissions, facility managers, and the general public.

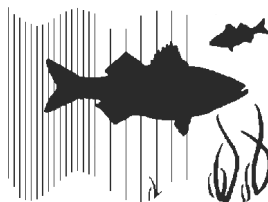
