

SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT
Chatham Borough, Chatham Township, Millburn Township,
New Providence Borough, and City of Summit
Lending of Vehicles, Equipment & Labor

WHEREAS, the Borough of Chatham, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, with its principal office located at Municipal Building, 54 Fairmount Avenue, Chatham, New Jersey 07928 (hereinafter “Chatham”) and the Township of Chatham, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, with its principal office located at Municipal Building, 58 Meyersville Road, Chatham, New Jersey, 07928 (hereinafter “Chatham Township”) and the Township of Millburn, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, with its principal office located at Municipal Building, 375 Millburn Avenue, Millburn, New Jersey, 07041 (hereinafter “Millburn Township”) and the City of Summit, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, with its principal office located at City Hall, 512 Springfield Avenue, Summit, New Jersey, 07901 (hereinafter “Summit”) and the Borough of New Providence, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, with its principal office located at Municipal Building, 360 Elkwood Avenue, New Providence, New Jersey, 07974 (hereinafter “New Providence”) have a need to lend to each other vehicles and equipment commonly used in Public Works; and

WHEREAS, this joint lending agreement between all three municipalities will increase services to the public, while decreasing operational costs for each municipality; and

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of Chatham, Chatham Township, Millburn Township, Summit and New Providence believe that it is in the best interests of the public to create a joint vehicle, equipment & labor lending program between all three municipalities; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is authorized pursuant to State Law, specifically, N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1, et. seq. – the “Inter-local Services Act”.

NOW, THEREFORE, Chatham, Chatham Township, Millburn Township, Summit and New Providence shall engage in the mutual covenants and agreements set forth below as follows:

1. In order to more economically and efficiently provide the described Joint Lending Agreement, Chatham, Chatham Township, Millburn Township, Summit and New Providence agree to share fleet & equipment inventories (attachment A) and update said inventories on a quarterly basis.

2. The Director of Public Works from Chatham, the Superintendent of Public Works from Summit and the Manager of Public Works from New Providence shall jointly establish a set of guidelines and recordkeeping for this lending program.

3. The term “Lender” shall constitute the Municipality loaning out a vehicle, piece of equipment or labor. The term “Borrower” shall constitute the Municipality that is receiving a vehicle, piece of equipment or labor for a pre-determined schedule of compensation defined in items #4 & #5.

4. Compensation will be in the form of “Hours of Credit”. A Lender will receive credit in one (1) hour increments. These hours of credit will be recorded in a central bank. A Lender

may use valid credit hours in each of the two other participating Municipalities for the purpose of borrowing inventory listed on attachment A. A debit will occur in the Borrowers credit bank account on each loan transaction. At the end of each calendar year, the balance of accumulated hours of credit will be carried over to the following year.

5. If a borrowed piece of equipment requires an equipment operator. Hourly compensation will double from one (1) to two (2) hours for each single hour worked. Hourly compensation will increase by one (1) hour for each additional employee loaned.

6. Chatham will act as the central credit bank administrator, tracking credit / debt hours and sending out monthly reports to all program participants (attachment B). It will be the responsibility of each participating municipality to report transactions to Chatham within twenty-four (24) hours of each occurrence.

7. As a starting point for the program, all participants will receive Fifty (50) credit hours.

8. It is the responsibility of each borrowing municipality to make a formal request for a loan of any inventory listed in attachment A at least seventy-two (72) hours in advance to the lending municipality. Request forms (attachment C) will be provided to each participating municipality. In the event of an emergency, this time limit policy will be waived.

9. Pre & post inspections will be conducted on all vehicles & equipment scheduled to be loaned out. It will be the responsibility of both the Lender & the Borrower to conduct a walk around inspection of the loaned item prior to its release, and again upon its return. A standard pre & post trip check list form (attachment D) will be provided to each participating municipality.

10. It is the responsibility of the borrowing municipality to incur any additional costs for parts, materials, fuels, and oils required to maintain & operate the vehicle or equipment on loan and return the equipment in the same condition as when it was loaned.

11. If a borrowed vehicle or piece of equipment breaks down while on loan, the Borrower shall immediately notify the lending Municipality of the breakdown. Within reasonable industry standards, the Borrower shall assume all costs associated to repair said vehicle or piece of equipment. The Lender will be responsible to make necessary repairs in-house and bill the borrowing municipality for parts and materials costs. Labor costs will be waived by the lending municipality. In the event repair work must be outsourced to a private vendor, the lending municipality will be required to provide the borrowing municipality with two (2) quotes from certified companies before repair work commences.

12. The lender is responsible to insure all borrowed vehicles will carry necessary insurance and have valid registrations & inspection stickers.

13. The Borough Administrator for the Borough of Chatham, the Township Administrator for the Township of Chatham, the Business Administrator for Millburn Township, the City Administrator for the City of Summit, and the Borough Administrator for the Borough of New Providence shall be responsible for resolving any disputes over the operation of this Agreement. Should these officials be unable to resolve the dispute, the involvement of an outside third party for review may be appropriate.

14. Chatham, Chatham Township, Millburn Township, Summit and New Providence shall not loan any inventory items currently on loan to them to any municipality who is not part of this agreement. Items currently on loan must be returned to the loaning agency, before it is transferred to another municipality.

15. Chatham, Chatham Township, Millburn Township, Summit and New Providence agree to indemnify and hold harmless the other from all losses, costs, expenses and reasonable attorney's fees for any claim of personal injury or property damage arising out of or connected with its use of any item listed in attachment A.

16. Chatham, Chatham Township, Millburn Township, Summit and New Providence represent to each other that all necessary municipal action to authorize and effectuate this agreement has been taken and that each municipality will take all future action reasonably necessary to effectuate the terms and conditions of this agreement during its term.

17. The parties agree that operators of equipment borrowed in accordance with this agreement will be qualified and adequately trained to operate said equipment. Operators of trucks, or other equipment operated on the public streets shall be properly licensed to operate said equipment.

18. This agreement shall expire on December 31, 2010. However, the agreement shall automatically renew upon expiration unless any party to said agreement submits written notification to the other participants of their desire to withdraw from said agreement. Said written notification shall be submitted to the other parties at least 60 days before the expiration of the agreement.

19. The following provisions shall apply to this agreement:

a. Construction of this Agreement.

The parties acknowledge that this Agreement was prepared under New Jersey Law and shall therefore be interpreted under the laws of the State.

b. Amendments

This Agreement may not be amended, altered or modified in any manner except in writing signed by the parties hereto.

c. Invalid Clause

The invalidity of any clause contained herein shall not render any other provision invalid and the balance of this Agreement shall be binding upon all parties hereto.

d. Entire Agreement

This document comprises the entire Agreement of the parties and it is acknowledged that there is no side or oral Agreement relating to this undertaking as set forth herein.

e. Assignability.

This Agreement and all rights, duties and obligations contained herein may not be assigned without all parties' prior written permission.

It is understood and agreed by the parties that a failure or delay in the enforcement of any of the provisions of this Agreement by either of the parties shall not be construed as a waiver of those provisions.
